There are 8 lathes mounted at 3 different heights, and associated equipment available for members use.

Senior members are available to provide advice and tuition.

There are two training portfolios for members - beginners and more advanced.

Some specialist equipment is available for hire to members at £3 per month.

MANY THANKS

A small number of members have clubbed together to allow the club to purchase a new Axminster lathe. The remaining funding was found by the sale of one of our older type lathes.

It is envisaged that this machine will be used for demonstrations, both at the club and outside venues. It has a larger capacity than the other machines and a short bed, which will help in the storage room.

Eric Mann has once again come the aid of the club and built a custom made bench which is easily transportable and will fit

in store in an upright position.

He has since added a Perspex guard to ensure maximum safety, especially on the educational visits.

At the time of writing it has yet to be used for demonstration purposes but is expected to be on show at the Church Fete on the 23rd June.

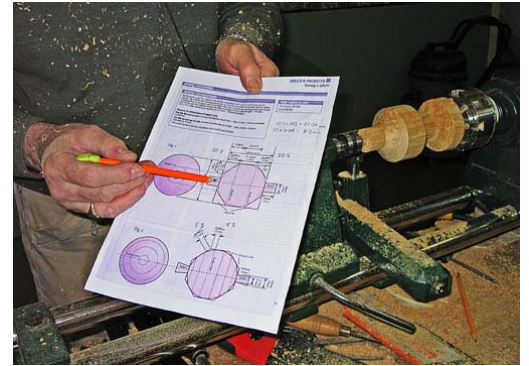

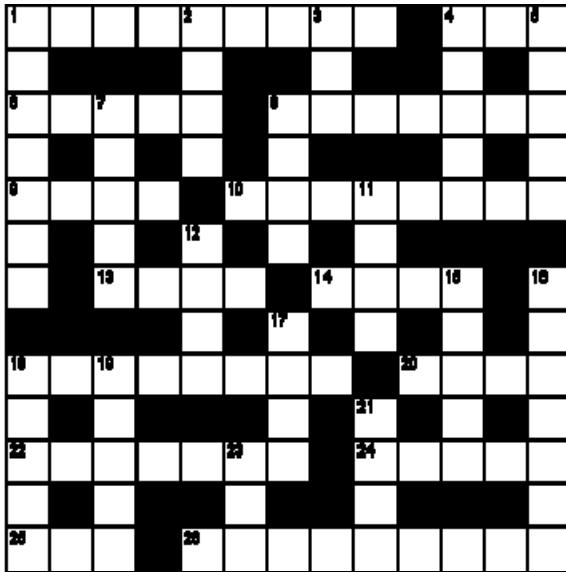


ERIC MANN
